### *Top of Europe- Jungfrauoch*

The Jungfrauoch is located in the middle of the Jungfrau-Aletsch-Bietschorn UNESCO World Heritage Site. The Sphinx lookout building, the Ice Palace, the plateau for walks in the eternal snow - these are year-round attractions on the Jungfrauoch-Top of Europe



### *Lauterbrunnen Grütschalp-Mürren*

From the Grütschalp cable car mountain station, a wide gravel path (also with prams) leads steadily uphill to the edge of the forest and on through a magnificent mountain forest. Wonderful alpine meadows open up and the view of the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau chain of peaks is unique.



### *Bouldering*

In the sports center of Grindelwald. Bouldering is suitable for young and old.

### *Iseltwald -Giessbach-Falls*

Hiking or by train/car. The masses of water tumble down 14 rock steps around 400m into Lake Brienz and offer a great natural spectacle. The oldest funicular in Europe leads from the boat station directly to the historically built Grand Hotel and the imposing Giessbach Falls.

### *Grindelwald – Bort*

*At the alpine playground in Bort, for example, there is a small mountain stream to dam, marmots and squirrels await you in the form of seesaws. The children can practice their balance while balancing on nets and ropes. Restaurant terrace open even in light rain. From Mühlebach or Wetterhorn hike up the road.*



### *Ischboden Alpine Bird Park*

*Between the village and the Grosse Scheidegg lies Ischboden. Native bird species are kept and cared for in 9 aviaries. There is a post bus stop right by the park and the 'Alpenvogelpark' can be reached by foot in 45 minutes from the Wetterhorn restaurant via the mountain road. Park is open 365 days, admission is free.*

Restaurant open usually Fri-Sun.



### *Crazy-Golf*

*In the village center of Grindelwald. In dry weather.*
