Energy Efficient Lighting & Appliances

We use energy-saving LED bulbs in the whole Chalet and motion detectors outdoors and in common areas.

Please turn off lights when absent or not in use.



Blinds

We have triple glazed windows and blinds that act as effective insulation, so summers are cool and winters are warm. Room temperatures can be adjusted with individual thermostats.

We have no air conditioning as it is not needed if blinds are used effectively. Fly nets enable you to air the apartment when temperatures drop at night.



Recycling

We also provide recycling points in our garage for PET plastic bottles, cardboard and glass. Please ask if you need guidance.

Grindelwald requires special green stickers on rubbish bags to encourage recycling.



Organic Garden

Our private organic garden is filled with local fruit, vegetables and native plants.
